

Lent is a season of forty days, not counting Sundays, which begins on Ash Wednesday and ends on Holy Saturday.
Lent comes from the Anglo-Saxon word lencten, meaning

"lengthen," and refers to the lengthening days of spring. The forty days also represent the time Jesus spent in the wilderness, where he was tested and prepared himself to begin his ministry.

Much like Jesus' time in the wilderness, Lent is often observed as a special time of honest self-reflection, introspection, and prayerfulness not only in our personal faith journeys but also communally as the body of Christ. It is also a time of preparation, and I can't think of a more fitting time than right now to prepare ourselves for the hope filled landscape ahead with the changing tide of COVID restrictions possibly loosing up this spring.

Before doing that, I thought what better way to honor this moment in time than to dig deeply into the foundations of our life together by examining Jesus' teachings in worship and preaching throughout Lent. This creates an opportunity for us to faithfully and intentionally invite Jesus himself to "Light the

Besides the emphasis on Jesus' teachings in Worship, here are other ways to grow in our faith together during Lent as preparation for the future ahead:

 2 at noon at Wabash Avenue

- 3) An **Ecumenical Good Friday Taize Service** at 7:30 at FCC with our ecumenical church partners.
- 4) FCC's annual Easter Weekend Prayer Vigil in the FCC Sanctuary that will begin after the Good Friday Service and end early Easter morning.

I'm looking forward to growing with you in our faith together as we prayerfully invite Jesus to "Light the Way" through Lent!

INDIANA DISCIPLES LENTEN BOOK STUDY!



The book, *Witness at The Cross* by Amy-Jill Levine will be used for the study. You can obtain a copy of the book from your favorite bookseller/library (options include Amazon and Thrift Books).

In Witness at the Cross, Amy-Jill Levine shows how the people at the cross each have distinct roles to play. Each Evangelist presents a distinct picture of the death of Jesus. Each portrays different individuals and groups of people at the cross, each offers different images and dialogues, and so from each, we will learn and discuss how those meanings and messages across the centuries speak to our own lives and communities in these times.




Week of Compassion Benefit Auction




