

No. Not your brother-in-law. But a male grizzly bear weighs about 700 pounds, some bigger, some smaller, and depending on the time of year.


A pair of African lions—lion and lioness together, charmingly posed above by a wedding photographer—will have a combined weight of about 700 pounds.
